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In order to participate in BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) activities, both parents and students must read, agree to, and follow the guidelines listed below.

1. Students and parents must have signed the Henry County R-1 School District Technology Use Agreement. Students violating this policy will be reported to administration for further disciplinary action.
2. Students in grades K-6 will check their device in with his/her teacher, upon arrival at school. The device will remain with the teacher throughout the day and will be locked in his/her closet when not in use by the owner of the device. Students will only be allowed to use the device when deemed appropriate by the teacher, and will check out the device at the end of the school day.
3. Please bring devices fully charged, as limited outlets are available for charging. If a charger is necessary, it is the responsibility of the student to supply the charger.
4. The school and/or district are not financially responsible for any downloaded applications purchased by students, data plan overages, or charges associated with texting/multimedia packages through your service provider.
5. Although every effort will be made to secure the devices throughout the school day, the school and/or district will not be held responsible for any loss, theft, or damage that may occur to the personal device.
6. Student devices and chargers must be labeled with the student name. If a name is not present on the device, the teacher will use tape to label the device. The teacher is not responsible for damages created from labeling the device, or cleaning any residue left behind by tape.
