This week our focus will be on words with long i spelled ie, i_e and igh. The assessment on Friday will contain these ten words that follow the pattern along with 2 dictation sentences.

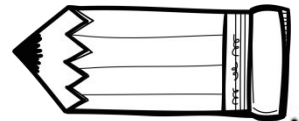

Math

In math this week we will be learning the following skills:

-compare and order length, weight, capacity, temperature and areas.

Vocabulary

Length-how long an object is.

Measure- to find length, height, or weight using standard or nonstandard units.

Weight- how much an object weighs

Students will practice visualizing to make sense of poetry and fiction.

As they visualize, they informally use schema and make inferences.
